With the scholarship you will also get the benefits of:

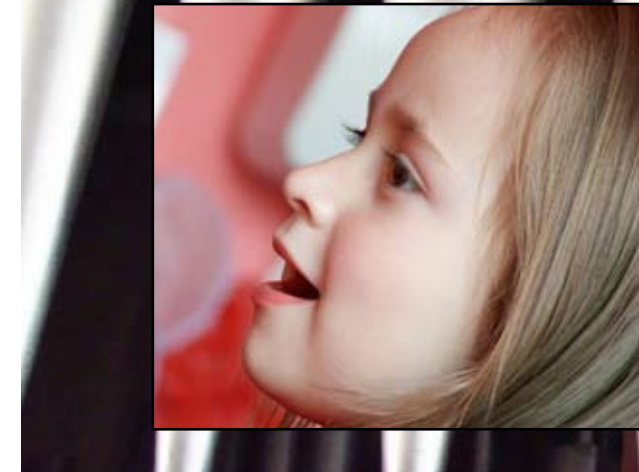
- Serving the St. Margaret's community with your voice.
